EDGENUITY ONLINE LEARNING 2016 SCHOOL YEAR COURSE SYLLABUS

1. TEACHER:	MR. CHAPMAN, Room 144
2. COURSE DESCRIPTION:	Edgenuity learning is an on-line, learning program. Students will be working on their assigned class on an assigned computer during the time spent in class.
3. LENGTH OF COURSE:	6 weeks, 0.50 credit/class. All classes are held Monday, June 20 to Friday, July 29, 2016 (No school July 4), 8 a.m. – 12 noon. All classes must be completed by (noon) July 29, 2016.
4. PREREQUISITE:	N/A or Pre-ceding class
5. TEXT:	Class is entirely on student.education2020.com
6. REFERENCE MATERIALS:	Text books in classroom
7. COURSE REQUIREMENTS:	Notes, Journals, Online Content, Labs, Essays, Projects, Interactives, Quizzes, Tests, and Cumulative Exam as indicated on the individual course outline
8. EVALUATION PROCEDURES:	Edgenuity content will be worth 100%, notes will be worth extra credit up to an additional 10% grade
9. UNITS OF INSTRUCTION:	Will vary based on course. Please see the individual class outline. All Edgenuity classes are aligned with the State of Michigan Curriculum.

10. COMPUTER ROOM GUIDELINES:

- Come to class prepared. This means that you have a notebook, a writing utensil, headphones, and anything else that you may need for your class. Teachers can loan students headphones, your assigned headphones are your responsibility and must be returned at the end of the day.
- Absolutely no food or drink allowed in the computer lab.
- The 2015-16 Acceptable Use of Technology Guidelines should be followed at all times.
- If the teacher assigns you a seat you are expected to be in your assigned seat for each day you are present. You are responsible for keeping your area clean. Please report any equipment issues immediately.

- You are expected to do your own work. If you are caught cheating you will receive a zero on the assignment and may fail the course. If you are caught cheating on a test or exam it is an automatic zero.
- If you have questions, please ask a teacher and do not disturb students around you.
- Personal conversations should be kept for outside of class.

11. SAFETY PROCEDURES: The safety procedures for fires, tornados, lockdowns, etc. are posted in the classroom and will be reviewed when necessary.

12. TAKING NOTES AND GENERAL INFORMATION:

- All notebook grades will be entered at the end of summer school.
- Notebooks presented to the teacher will be checked and may account for up to a 10% boost in a student's final grade. Remember that notebooks can also be used on all quizzes and tests.
 - To receive full extra credit, notes must have the following criteria:
 - Date
 - Heading of the Section
 - Vocabulary words and definitions
 - Notes/Examples from the lecture (very important for Math courses)
 - Notes from online content
 - You will be allowed **one** retake for each quiz and test. You must take the initiative to go back and retake these on your own.
 - There will be no additional retakes or answers to quizzes or tests given
 - No assignments will be reset.
 - All cumulative exams must be taken in class unless prior arrangements have been made

13. HOW TO BE SUCCESSFUL:

- You must reach 100% of the class **and** complete the cumulative exam in order for the course to be considered satisfied. Once you have completed the cumulative exam, you must have a grade of 59.5% or higher in order to receive 0.50 credit for the class. No incompletes are given. If a class is not finished by (noon) the last day of summer school with a passing grade, an E will be assigned as the final grade.
- You will be allowed to use your notebook for all quizzes and tests. You only have 2 chances on the quizzes and tests and it will record your highest score of the 2 attempts.
- Make sure you are keeping track of your target completion percentage. If you are behind, attendance may be required to catch up. Do not wait until the last minute.
- Although attendance in the online summer school program is not mandatory, it may become mandatory if at any time during summer school your student falls more than 10% behind target completion and/or your student has a failing grade. If a student is more than 10% behind a phone call will be made home and attendance for summer school may

become mandatory until your student gets back on target completion and/or improves their failing grade.

• Your cooperation in assuring that your student is adequately working towards completion of summer school classes while working outside of the school is essential for your student's success.
